


# Android Wi-Fi both BMP®51 and BMP®61 Printers

#### **Connect to LinkWare Live**

- 1. Go to phone settings
- 2. Tap Wi-Fi
- 3. Tap the BMP51 or BMP61 printer to connect
- 4. Open the Brady Text Labels app
- 5. Select a printer and material



6. Tap the pencil icon, new screen appears



7. Tap the keyboard icon to expand icons



8. Tap the page icon, cloud storage options open



9. Tap the LinkWare icon at the bottom of the screen



10. Enter your Fluke Networks login credentials



4. Select label set




5. Set rows to print (up to 100)

1. Tap print icon




# **Android Bluetooth BMP51 Printer Only**

#### **Connect to LinkWare Live**

  - a. Turn Bluetooth on if it is turned off
- 3. Tap the BMP51 printer to connect
- 4. Open the Brady Text Labels app
- 5. Select a printer and material

8. Tap the page icon, cloud storage options open




9. Tap the LinkWare icon at the bottom of the screen






